COUNT 2:

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 1, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that she may have endangered herself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in her vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 1, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully and with the intent to mislead Columbia Police Officer Nathan Ginn, a peace officer, as to her identity, gave a false name to the officer, who had asked for the Defendant's identifying information in the lawful discharge of his official duties and had warned the Defendant that the giving of false identifying information is a criminal offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 1, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 1, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a third such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about December 1, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over numerous items of personal property, having a value of less than \$500, same being the moveable property of Walmart, with

the intent to deprive the owner thereof, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
