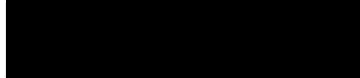
COUNT 3:

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 13, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he did not have his operator's license in his possession, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 13, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevented or attempted to prevent Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee, who was recognized to be acting under color of official authority, from effecting an arrest of the defendant by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee, or by using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 13, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed amphetamine, a Schedule II narcotic drug, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about July 13, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation of physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol

and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his first such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of his blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 1:

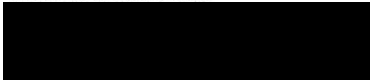
COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 12th – 30th, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having been convicted of a “sex-crime” as such term is defined in KRS 17.500(6), he knowingly and unlawfully failed to notify the appropriate local probation and parole office of a change in his residence address, in violation of KRS 17.510, or he otherwise failed to comply with any provisions of the Kentucky Sex Offender Registration requirements set forth in KRS 17.510, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about May 12th – 30th, 2024, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Failure to Comply with Sex Offender Registration, contrary to KRS 17.510(11), and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of a prior felony offense, with the previous conviction being a conviction of a felony in this state or convicted of a crime in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offense was committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of May 12th – 30th, 2024, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from the previous felony conviction at the date(s) of May 12th – 30th, 2024, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date(s) of May 12th – 30th, 2024, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
