The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 23, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, received, retained, or disposed of a .380 caliber Sig Sauer P238 semi-automatic

handgun, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, knowing that said property had been stolen or having reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the property was not received, retained, or disposed of with the intent to restore it to its lawful owner, said property being a firearm, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about February 23, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Receiving Stolen Property - Firearm, contrary to KRS 514.110, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of a prior felony offense, with the previous conviction being a conviction of a felony in this state or convicted of a crime in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offense was committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date of February 23, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from the previous felony conviction at the date of February 23, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on the previous felony conviction within five (5) years prior to the date of February 23, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle in Downtown Burkesville and northbound on KY highway 61, at a speed of twenty-six (26) miles per hour or greater above the posted speed limit, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally placed Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to innocent bystanders, when the Defendant drove a stolen Ford pickup truck in the opposing traffic lane during a pursuit with Kentucky State Police, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree when, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he wantonly engaged in conduct which created a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee, when the Defendant drove a stolen Ford pickup truck in the direction of where Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee was standing on the side of the roadway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on a highway in a manner that was without regard for the safety and convenience of pedestrians and other vehicles upon the highway, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle at such time as he did not possess a valid operator's license, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Terroristic Threatening in the Third Degree when he threatened to commit any crime likely to result in the death or serious physical injury to another person(s) or likely to result in substantial property damage to another person(s), when he threatened to punch Kentucky State Trooper Matthew Lee in the face, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, while operating a motor vehicle with the intent to elude or flee, the defendant knowingly or wantonly disobeyed a direction to stop his motor vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer, and the defendant was fleeing immediately after committing an act or domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720, and/or by fleeing or eluding, the defendant was the cause of, or created a substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death to another person(s) or property, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant received, retained, or disposed of a 2008 Ford pickup truck, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner, and the defendant knew that the property had been stolen or had reason to believe that it had been stolen, and the defendant did not receive, retain, or dispose of the property with the intent to return it to the owner, said property having a value of \$1,000 or more, but less than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 10:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated or was in physical control of a motor vehicle at such time as the Defendant had an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) of a sample of the Defendant's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the influence of alcohol; or while the Defendant was under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impaired the Defendant's driving ability; or while the presence of a controlled substance listed in KRS 189A.010(12) was detected in the Defendant's blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test(s) taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; or while the Defendant was under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability, this being his first such offense within a ten (10) year period, and the Defendant refused to submit to any test or tests of his blood, breath, or urine requested by an officer having reasonable grounds to believe the Defendant was operating

or in physical control of a motor vehicle in violation of Subsection (1) of KRS 189A.010, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 11:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operated a motor vehicle on the left side of the roadway when approaching or upon the crest of a grade or a curve in the highway where his view was obstructed within such distance as to have created a hazard in the event another vehicle might have approached from the opposite direction; or approaching within one hundred (100) feet of or traversing any intersection or railroad grade crossing; or when his view was obstructed upon approaching within one hundred (100) feet of any bridge, viaduct or tunnel, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 12:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 30, 2025, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offenses of Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree - Police Officer, contrary to KRS 508.060; Fleeing or Evading Police in the First Degree – Motor Vehicle, contrary to KRS 520.095; and Receiving Stolen Property \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, contrary to KRS 514.110(3B), and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 30, 2025, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of March 30, 2025, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of March 30, 2025, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
