The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 16, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly entered or remained unlawfully in a residence / dwelling owned by [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to commit a crime, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 16, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully entered or remained in or upon the premises of [REDACTED] and/or another person, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 16, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that he may have endangered himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in his vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 16, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully took or exercised control over five (5) football jerseys, \$400 in cash inside a white waist fanny pack, four (4) Social Security cards, wedding/engagement ring, and/or miscellaneous other items of personal property, same being the movable property of [REDACTED] and/or another person, with the intent to deprive the owner thereof, said property having a value of \$1,000 or more but less than \$10,000, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Count 5:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 16, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense(s) of Burglary in the Second Degree, in violation of KRS 511.030; and Theft By Unlawful Taking/Disposition - \$1,000 Or More But Less Than \$10,000, in violation of KRS 514.030, and at that time the defendant was a person more than twenty-one (21) years of age, who stood convicted of at least two (2) prior felony offenses, with the previous convictions being convictions of felonies in this state or convicted of crimes in any other jurisdiction, and that a sentence to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year or more was imposed

therefore, and the defendant was over the age of eighteen (18) years at the time the offenses were committed and the defendant completed the service of the sentence imposed on at least one (1) of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of June 5, 2026, or the defendant was on probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, furlough, appeal bond, or any other form of legal release from any of the previous felony convictions at the date of April 16, 2026, or the defendant was discharged from probation, parole, conditional discharge, conditional release, or any other form of legal release on any of the previous felony convictions within five (5) years prior to the date of April 16, 2026, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

defendant appeared in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol, not therapeutically administered, to the degree that she may have endangered herself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoyed persons in her vicinity, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 1, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 1, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully introduced a baggie containing suspected methamphetamine, same being dangerous contraband, into the Adair County Regional Jail, or being a person confined in the Adair County Regional Jail, she knowingly made, obtained, or possessed a baggie containing suspected methamphetamine, same being dangerous contraband, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about April 1, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when she knowingly and unlawfully possessed methamphetamine, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

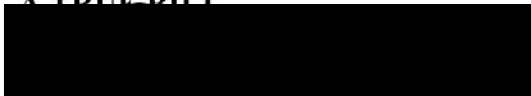

COUNT 2:


The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 19, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed with the intent to use, drug paraphernalia for the purpose of planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packing, re-packing, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a controlled substance in violation of KRS 218A, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 19, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant committed the offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree when he knowingly and unlawfully possessed hydrocodone, a controlled substance that is classified in Schedule II and is a narcotic drug, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Grand Jury of Adair County, Kentucky, charges that on or about March 19, 2026, and before the finding of the Indictment herein, in Adair County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having been prescribed, sold, or dispensed a controlled substance by a practitioner or other person authorized pursuant to KRS Chapter 218A, unlawfully possessed the controlled substance in a container other than that in which it was delivered to him by the person selling or dispensing same, this being a first such offense, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
